

The camp is geared towards family participation. Campers will attend classes on trapping methods, ethics, regulations, fur handling, health and safety. Camp instructors come from the MTA education program.

Funding for YTC comes from camp fees, YTC Membership Gifts, Individual and Corporate donations. YTC, Inc. provides scholarships for youth attendees if requested, prior to April 15 each year.
