- 1. The deadline for scholarship applications is May 1st, 2024.
- 2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements.
- 3. Scholarship will be awarded on June 1st, 2024.

## Purpose:

To provide a scholarship for \$2,000 to a graduating senior or continuing undergraduate study or Maters program intending to pursue a degree in Furbearer or Wildlife Management, Natural Resources or other life science major or related field.

#### Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must between the ages of 17 and 25.
- 2. Applicant must submit a type written essay that dispels one or more myths of trapping.
- 3. Applicant must be a member in good standing of the Montana Trapper Association.

# Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Brief letter with an explanation of student involvement in activities to include MTA programs, trapping, community service and school programs.
- 2. Completed application form typed.
- 3. Two (2) Letter of Recommendation by current MTA members (non-family), MTA District Director, Subdirector, from the district where application resides, or other pertinent individuals must be included with the application.
- 4. An official and recent transcript with cumulative grade point average, ACT and / or SAT scores, and a class standing / rank.
- 5. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited, post-secondary institution.
